Dear Friends,

Are you ready for Christmas? Too soon? Before long, you will be asked this question over and over. Many of us will say, "No." In most instances, our negative response will not be mean-spirited or exasperated but it will be a reminder that there are things to do. Is there enough time? What do I get for Aunt Jean and Uncle Wally? Where are we holding Christmas this year? Do I need to bring a main dish? Who's planning what and when? The questions go on and on and the anxiety goes higher and higher.

There's a lot that goes into preparing for Christmas. List making, Shopping, traveling, decorating, wondering how you will pay for everything and the overwhelming feeling that you've forgotten something. It can be maddening. There must be a better way to get ready for Christmas.

I read an English Proverb the other night that says there are, "Three phrases that sum up Christmas are: Peace on Earth, Goodwill to All, and Batteries not Included".

Batteries not included! The worst thing that can happen to any kid on Christmas morning, is to get that new supercharged toy you've been dying to have since you saw that commercial in October and then you can't play with it because grandma forgot to buy batteries. Disappointing?

Many of us feel like we are people whose packaging could say, "Batteries Not Included." When Christmas finally gets here, we are exhausted. Why are we so tired? Is it because of all the energy we had to expend to prepare for the holiday? Or is it because, we've been stressed out for so many weeks that the preparation for Christmas feels like doing your taxes. You begin to think, "I hope I can get

through it.” Is that really the kind of hope you want for Christmas? Where’s the joy? Where’s the “Peace on Earth.” We need anticipation rather than anxiety.

So, is there a better way? I believe there is. It’s called Advent.

In church, we observe Advent for four Sundays before Christmas day. In reality, the actual advent of the coming Messiah went on for centuries. God promised prophets like Samuel, Jeremiah, and Isaiah that there would come one who was like no other. He would be the Savior, Wonderful Counselor, Prince of Peace, King above all kings. They anticipated! Expected! Wondered about! Prayed for! Sought after! The coming Christ and the fulfillment of God’s promise.

I can only imagine the feelings of anticipation Mary and Joseph met after having been told by an angel that they would be parents to the Messiah. I wonder about their emotions when required to travel from Nazareth to Bethlehem when Mary was about to give birth. There was no room at the Inn. Forced to take shelter in a stable that was more likely a cave used to keep animals. Anticipation? Expectation?

Jesus is born, it’s my guess that Joseph and Mary were completely exhausted but also filled with incredible energy because of the birth of a baby boy. It was a new beginning. God brought to the world the life who would give life. What a story!

Let Advent be something more than just the things we do on Sunday just before Christmas. Read the story. Listen to the intricacies and challenges that arose during the adventure. Imagine yourself there. Hear the words of the prophets. Sing the songs of the psalmists who praises the God of salvation. Hope, Love, Joy, and Peace are the themes for Advent. Ask God to use these as the source of power. These are the gifts of God that replace anxiety with anticipation. There are a lot of distractions so you will have to be focused. Pray, think, and practice Hope, Love, Joy, and Peace. Look for God in the simple things. God is there. So is Christmas. Live the next few weeks with your eyes on God and with an attitude of anticipation. On Christmas day, you may be exhausted but you will also be empowered with new life! And when someone asks you, “Are you ready for Christmas?” You might still say, “No.” But the good news is you can come to Christmas with “Batteries Enclosed.”

Becky and I hope that you have a blessed, safe and Merry Christmas.






