Prayer for 40 Days

Pastor E. Doh From Our

Lent is the Christian season of preparation before Easter. In Western Christianity, Ash Wednesday marks the first day, or the start of the season of Lent, which begins 40 days before Easter (Sundays are not included in the count).

The number 40 holds particular significance in the Bible. There are at least ten instances in the Old Testament and New Testament where 40 occurs, either in years or days, e.g. it rained for 40 days and 40 nights, Moses was on the mountain 40 days and 40 nights, the Israelites wandered 40 years, Jesus fasted and tempted in the wilderness for 40 days and was seen on the earth for 40 days after His crucifixion.

I want to invite our church family to join our Lenten study. During the Lenten season, we will gather to share our lives, meditate, and pray. This 6 weeks journey will help us experience the power of prayer and meditation.

For those who are not able to join the Lenten study, let me share with you some simple guidelines.

Prepare your heart for fellowship with God. Open your heart with some music or singing songs. You can choose a scripture for meditation but don't stay too long. This is not a Bible study. The most important part is inviting the Holy Spirit to come and illumine your heart. Rather than rushing into God's presence and saying many things, it is good many times to quieten your mind and wait in God's presence so you can feel God's heart and pray the things that the Holy Spirit shows you to pray for. It is the Spirit who is to lead us in the kind of prayer we offer to God. He gives us the power to pray.

Begin with Praise and Thanksgiving. "Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name." (Psalm 100:4). Tell Him how great He is. Praising God for His goodness, faithfulness, and greatness, especially for the wonderful blessing.

Having a purpose in Prayer. You can pray for yourself, your family, and others in the church and their needs, national and local situations, and the government. Please remember the people in Palestine and Ukraine. Please join us on our 40-day prayer journey.
