“Who Is Knocking?” *...Continued*

As difficult as it is to imagine today, millions of people around the world flocked to see what was known as the “sermon in a frame.” The allegorical painting that captured the imagination of so many was created by the English artist William Holman Hunt, who began the work at the age of 21 and finished it when he was 29. The painting illustrates the biblical passage in Revelation 3:20, “Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, [then] I will enter his house and dine with him, and he with me.” Jesus, carrying a lantern, is depicted knocking at a door with no handle on the outside. The door is overgrown with weeds, and the nails and hinges are rusted, implying that the door has never been opened. The message: it is up to the person on the other side of the door to let Jesus in. The original, life-sized version of The Light of the World is located in the chapel of Keble College, Oxford, England.

When I contemplate the timeless meaning of this image, I am made aware of how appropriate this image is for the season of Lent.

First, let me ask you the question I had asked myself, when I was looking at this image. Today, If someone knocks at your door, what reaction do you have?

Well, we in the present age of cell phones don't really go knocking at our family or friends doors unless we first text or call them of our coming. I am personally surprised when I hear a knock at my parsonage door if I am not expecting anyone. The first thing that comes to mind is, maybe a church member got locked out of the church or is it someone asking to sell something or asking for some kind of help? In our times, knocking on doors does not often bring happy curiosity but instead an anxious concern. This and other images of “Jesus knocking on the Door”, is a metaphor of the spiritual attention/ invitation to seek and understand Jesus's call to an individual and to the Church.

Jesus' words “I stand at the door and knock” in Revelation 3:20, were said in the context of Jesus trying to get the attention of the Church in Laodicea, whom he felt were far from Him. I believe that we also can get far from God when we are totally distracted in fulfilling our relational and work obligations, resulting in our relationship with God being put on the back burner. In the end, we are the ones who miss God's blessings, insight and wisdom that we desperately need in navigating our daily lives. In the Bible, we find many places where the image of “knocking at the door” of our hearts is used to emphasize God's call or God's way of getting our attention. I can relate to this as a parent. When I feel I have not spoken to or seen my kids for a long time. When we do catch-up I get responses back from them such as “I wish I had talked to you about this matter first” or “I knew you would help me get to a solution if we had spoken”.

Unlike strangers knocking on our home doors can make us feel anxious, Jesus knocking on our hearts is a knock of love and an invitation. To those who would open the door, Jesus promised a close fellowship - pictured as enjoying a meal together.

Today Jesus continues to say, “I stand at the door and knock!” to churches who are filled with nominal Christians, and to Christians who are far away from Him. He sends out His earnest invitation for full fellowship. In our prayer life with Jesus we are nurtured, built up, matured in our spiritual perspective and receive countless blessings. Jesus continues to call us all to hear His voice and open the door so that He can come in and share an intimate union with us.

Our Church is providing during Lent, weekly time of devotions on Tuesday's Lenten Services followed by lunch of soup & bread. Also check out all the Holy Week's events to enhance our Lenten Journey of Faith. A Journey of 40 days where believers in Jesus Christ focus more closely on our relationship with God, in light of what Jesus has done for us on the Cross of Calvary and what he continues to do for us in our everyday lives.
