“FAITH: Bearing Summer Fruit!”

June comes with high expectations for the summer. All the schools are out for summer break and there is a restful atmosphere full of anticipation of the warm weather, full bloom flowers in gardens and pots and an expectation of a bumper crop of vegetables for those who are gardeners at heart. June is when plans for family trips and visits and cook outs are planned. It is indeed a beautiful part of the year.

Summer is also used as a metaphor for that stage in life when we are young and full of life, ambitions and ready to explore all that life has to offer. Tim Hahn in his article says about the summer of life; “Next is the summer, usually from ages 21-41, and this is the time when we go off for battle (*literally and figuratively*), build new habits and put in the work. It is a time when we test what we know. We are in discovery mode, trying to find out who we really are. If we do the work, we learn much and have lots of growing pains. This can be a very hard time for most as we are shedding layers of adolescence and immaturity, feeling very vulnerable. Our youthfulness can be forgotten as life becomes fast-paced with responsibilities and the expectations of others.”

This may be the secular way of perceiving the summer of life. But the Christian world view does not align with this limited view of the season of summer in the life of an individual. We are told in many parts of the Biblical literature that God gives us seasons of growth in different parts of our lives and in different seasons of our lives. We are not bound by our ages or youthful agility to show growth, successes or progress.

Solomon informs us that if we cooperate with God’s purposes and timing, life will not be meaningless. Everything, even the most difficult experiences of life, will be “beautiful in its time”.

*“He has made everything beautiful in its time. He has also set eternity in the human heart;
yet no one can fathom what God has done from beginning to end.” (Ecclesiastes 3:11)*

From a spiritual perspective our success or growth is dependent on our relationship with God. Who can bless us when we are young or old or very old. In all and every season of our life there are many summers to be had. Where we can see fruitfulness, growth, vitality and blessings. The key is knowing God, loving God and serving God all the days of our lives.

Paul says, “*And let us not get tired of doing what is right, for after a while we will reap a harvest of blessing if we don’t get discouraged and give up*” (Galatians 6:9)

Explore your season. Learn and see what God is doing. God may be using you to bear fruit you have not yet seen, in your relationships, at work, in ministry at Church or in service in your community. Let God be your gardener and bring a summer in your life wherever you are planted.

*“Learn a lesson from a fig tree. When its branches sprout and start putting out leaves,
you know that Summer is near” (Matthew 24:32).*
