A NOTE *from* PASTOR AYL A

“MAY” We Make Disciples!

May is the last month of astronomical spring in the Northern Hemisphere and of astronomical fall in the Southern Hemisphere. It is amazing that our planet has such contrasting climates in the different regions of the world. We are embracing late spring in the Channahon landscape but on the opposite side of the world, like in Sydney Australia - where my husband's family lives - they are getting ready for Winter. They are now pulling out their sweaters and coats. It is a surprising reality we are usually not aware of unless we travel to the Southern Hemisphere. What contrasting experiences at the same time in different parts of the world.

We as Christians also live in contrasting reality despite the natural season or season of life. You see, we who have recently celebrated the Resurrection of Jesus Christ: we believe, we claim & we experience the joy and hope we have in the saving grace of Jesus the Christ. There are many in this world who do not believe, or claim or experience this Spiritual Truth. Therefore they live in despair and hopelessness whether they are religious or secular. This is a spiritual contrast that is not obviously visible but it determines a lot of a person's attitude, behavior and perception of life.

Our Christian Faith gives us a focus to live above the contrasts of life: shifting sands of circumstances, financial thin or thick, love or no love, successes or failures, sickness or health, life or death. We are to have a temporal & eternal perspective, at the same time. Christians are encouraged to do life with others in a Church family. To lean on the presence of God in the life of the individual and the life of a community called church. And to have hope for eternal contentment and peace cultivated by the Holy Spirit.

Jesus said “I am the way and the truth and the life”. (*John 14:6*)

Unfortunately, for those who do not know this way, this truth or this life are missing out. There are many in our community who have no spiritual home/group to belong to, they have to lean heavily on family, relationships, money, stuff, social and political clanship, to bring contentment, peace and purpose in life. Many times these leanings don't come through or leave the heart empty and thirsty.

So shall we just live with these contrasts? Jesus empowered his simple, rag-tag, unsophisticated, fishermen disciples to go make more disciples, and not accept the contrast.

Let us ask Jesus to empower us today and make us contrast breakers, people who influence with hope, joy, contentment and peace. Our purpose and value is not in who we are or what we have but to **Whom** we belong to and **Who** has us in His hands.
